


## **Ethical Policy:**

No registration fee is charged for publishing papers. However, charges for the hard copy of the journal will have to be paid.


### **Authors' Responsibilities**

- The author needs to confirm that the manuscript submitted to us is not under consideration or accepted for publication anywhere else.
- He/she should confirm that all the work in the submitted manuscript is original and he/she needs to share the sources from where the content is taken.
- The author must not submit a manuscript to more than one journal simultaneously, nor should he/she should submit previously published work, nor work which is based in substance to previously published work.
- An author must ensure the consent of all named co-authors for publication and being named as a co-author. At the same time all those persons who have made significant scientific or literary contributions to the work submitted are named as co-authors. Here, it is obvious that the co-authors are bound by the same principles.



## **Reviewers' Responsibilities**

- The Reviewer is expected to maintain the confidentiality of any information supplied by the editor or author. He/she is not supposed to retain a copy of the manuscript.
- He/she will contribute to the decision-making process, and will assist in improving the quality of the published paper by reviewing the manuscript objectively, in a timely manner;
- The Reviewer is expected to alert the editor to any published or submitted content that is substantially similar to that which is under review.
- Although the authors' identity is normally hidden, the content within a manuscript may reveal an author's identity. In such cases, a peer reviewer of a manuscript must give unbiased consideration to each manuscript submitted for consideration for publication, and should judge each on its merits, without any regard to race, religion, nationality, sex, seniority, or institutional affiliation of the author(s).



## **Editors' Responsibilities**

- The Editor should give unbiased consideration to each manuscript submitted for publication, and should judge each on its merits and no other criteria such as race, religion, nationality, sex etc.
- Editor has sole responsibility for the acceptance or the rejection of a submitted manuscript.
- The Editor may reject a submitted manuscript without sending it for the formal peer review if she/he considers the manuscript to be inappropriate for the Journal.
- The Editor is expected to make all reasonable efforts to process the submitted manuscripts in an efficient and timely manner.
- Editor, Associate Editors, and the members of the Editorial Board should treat the peer review process as entirely confidential, and neither the submitted manuscript, nor information about the submitted manuscript, nor correspondence related to their peer review should be shared or circulated to any other person who is not engaged in the peer review process.
